COVID-19 SELF-SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE

DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS?

new or worsening cough shortness of breath difficulty breathing fever/chills sore throat nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

runny/stuffy nose (not allergies) headache muscle aches unusual fatigue acute loss of sense of smell or taste

If you have answered "YES" to any of the above questions, **please do not send your child to school at this time**, **unless your child's symptoms fall under the exception noted below in yellow.** Consult your health care provider or call 811 to determine when you can return to school and whether you need to be tested for COVID-19.

If you have answered "NO" to all the above questions, you may send your child to school.

Exception: If your child has on-going, existing conditions and symptoms that would not be new or unusual for that individual (e.g., chronic allergies), this alone will not require someone to stay home from school. However, if existing symptoms become more extreme than usual or are accompanied by the onset of new symptoms, it would be important to consult with a health care provider to determine if staying home or getting a COVID test is recommended.
